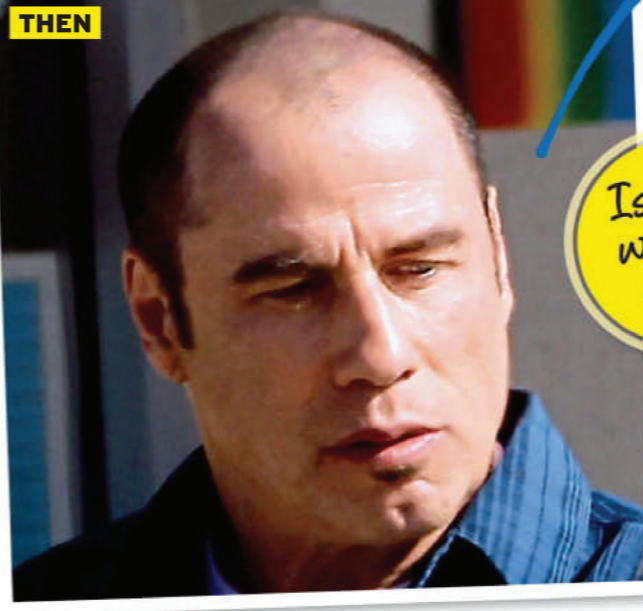


## MATTHEW MCCONAUGHEY, 47

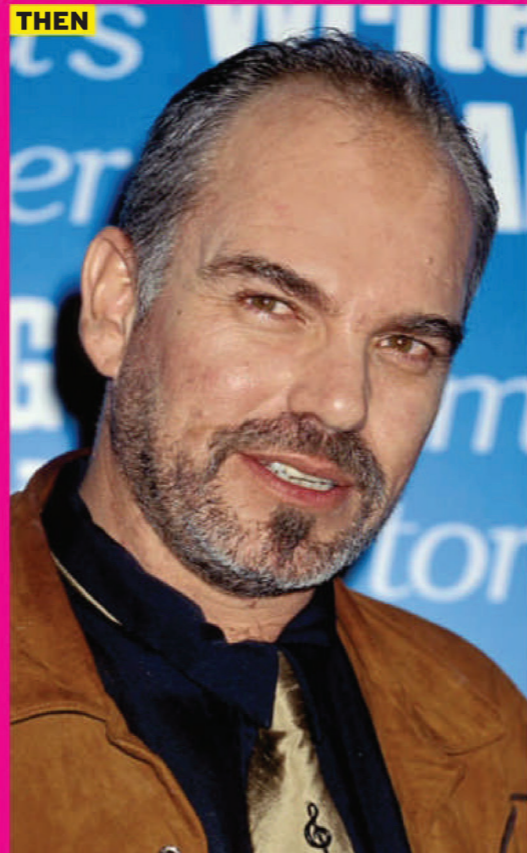
## A.J. MCLEAN, 39

A.J.'s hair is back, all right! The *Backstreet Boy* shared before and after photos on Instagram, proudly embracing his new follicles.

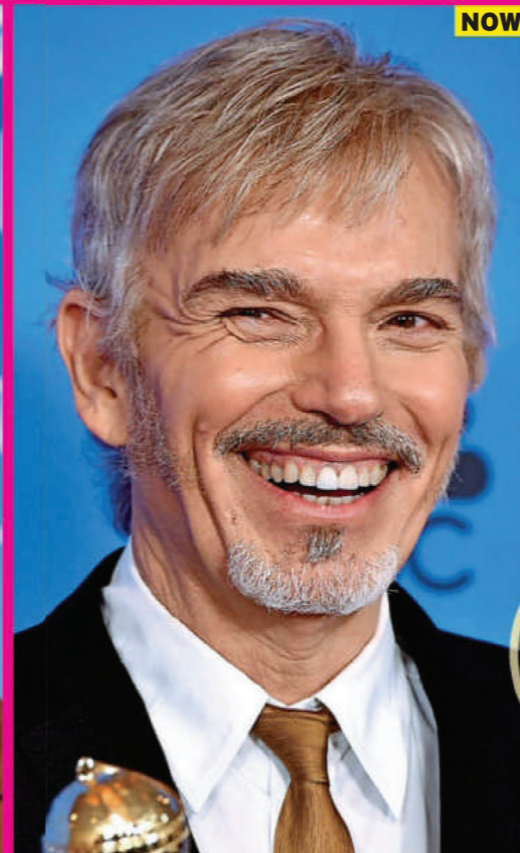
His transplant gives him "an age-appropriate hairline that complements his face," Dr. Armani notes.

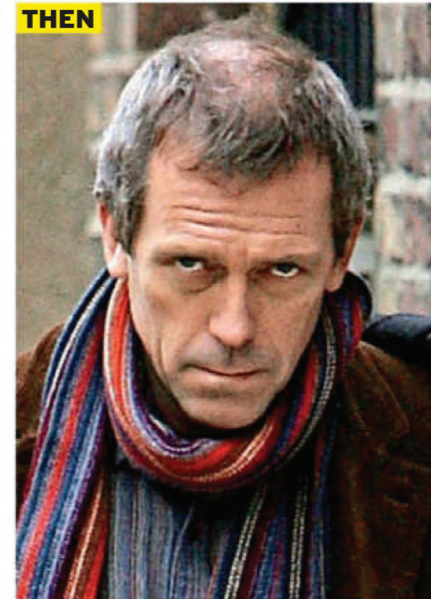


## BILLY BOB THORNTON, 61
